### BTEC Creative Media Production

You are working on the new series of 'The Good Wife' day 1 of filming includes shooting 3 key scenes:

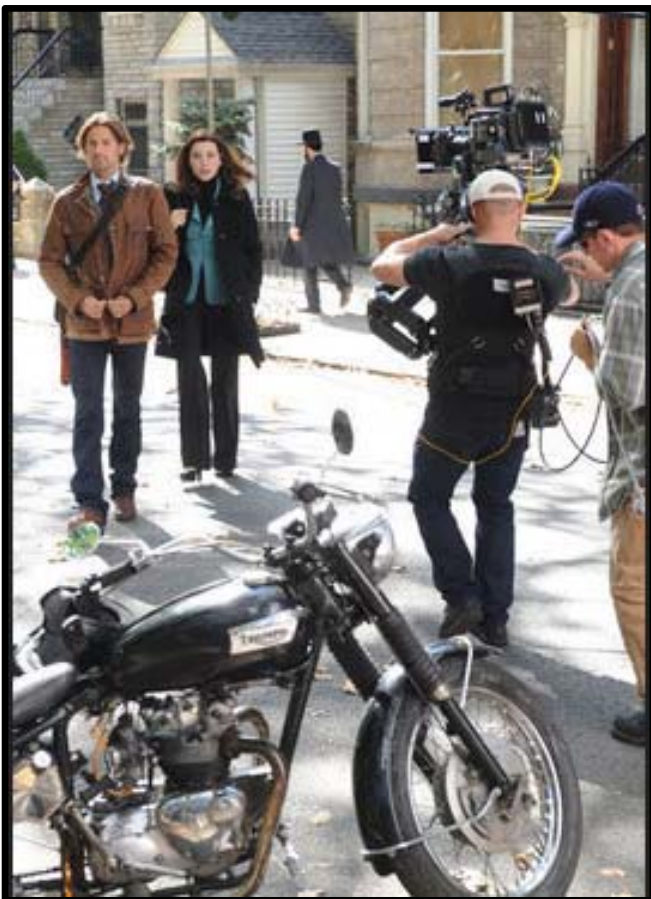
Scene 1: (Crime) Drunk man crashes van in to another car

Scene 2: (Recovery) Victim in the hospital receiving emergency surgery due to head injury

Scene 3: (In court) Defence lawyers in court arguing case that driver was not over the alcohol limit.

Before you start filming on location you must devise a pre-production and post-production list.

Choose one scene that you will consider the pre and post production process for. Use the internet to help you research roles and preparation taken out by producers and directors.



**What is pre-production?** Planning of a product, especially a film or broadcast programme before full-scale production begins. This includes preparation such as story boarding, casting and rehearsing.

**What is post production?** Work done on a film or recording after filming or recording has taken place. Including editing effects and adding non diegetic sound (music the actors cannot hear)

**When filming it is vital you and your crew members are prepared for a productive smooth time on set. Pre-production and organisation is just as important as the post production, without prior preparation the post production process becomes very challenging.**
