GREEN	Student is fully engaged and producing good quality work.

## UCAS Launch 2021 Entry





“Hello everyone,

I am sure you will have been following the news about proposals for a partial reopening of schools and colleges on Monday 1st June. The government issued its guidance late last night and the senior team at college has been digesting it through today.
