

Do I need to wear a face mask to travel on a Wyke Sixth Form College East Yorkshire Bus or one of our minibus services?

Answer – Yes you will need to wear a face mask until Government Guidance changes. We will keep you informed when this changes.

How much does it cost to travel on a Wyke Sixth Form College East Yorkshire Bus?

Answer – It costs 75p per journey for local routes which, if possible, should be paid using a contactless card on the bus. However, a cash payment will be accepted on the bus. If you live outside of Hull or West Hull villages it is best to buy an 'e ticket' which works on a smart phone. How much does it cost to travel on a Wyke Sixth Form Minibus?

Answer – You can pay for travel on our minibuses via your ParentPay account. Can I use any Wyke Sixth Form East Yorkshire Bus or Minibus if I am just registered to use one?

Answer – Yes you can. Wyke Bus Passes can be used on any of the East Yorkshire Buses services that are operated for the College. You can also use them on College operated minibus services if needed. However, you will need to check there is capacity on the chosen minibus you would like to use with the Premises Manager who is located in Oak 5. If you are travelling to college on one of our minibuses, we do not usually issue tickets. However, if you feel you would like to use an East Yorkshire Bus operated by Wyke, just let your driver know you would like a pass making. We will then create a pass for you that can be used on any of the East Yorkshire Buses College operated runs. Can I travel Ad-hoc on buses and minibuses without a pass?

Answer – Travel on East Yorkshire buses outside of the 75p zone and all minibuses will be permitted on an ad-hoc basis without a pass, but the cost will be double that of a normal journey on the bus pass cost (£3). On one of our minibus services you will need to buy single journey ticket from the college library, which again will be double pass price (£3), before you travel. If you plan to also make a return journey on a minibus, make sure you buy two tickets! Will I get a reminder when my bus or minibus pass is due for renewal?

Answer – Yes you will. If you purchase a bus pass via the East Yorkshire Buses ‘e-ticket’ it will count down until the date you are due to make the next payment. If you are purchase a Minibus pass for any period we will aim to remind you if a payment is late. Minibus users will be contacted via the email address linked to the ParentPay account. Where can catch my bus or minibus when travelling into college?

Answer – For East Yorkshire Buses you can get on at any stop on the route (not just those shown on the timing points on the College website). You will just need to estimate the arrival time. Please aim to be at your stop 5 minutes before the timetabled arrival time and always put your arm out. For our minibus services there are designated pick-up points shown on the College website, so please be there 5 minutes before the arrival time.

Where can I catch my bus or minibus when travelling home?

Answer – For East Yorkshire Buses there are two pick-up points. Please check where your bus picks up from by following this link <http://www.wyke.ac.uk/student-life/travelling-to-wyke> as it may not be the same location as you were dropped off. All minibuses pick-up at the rear of the Sports Hall which is located in the Oak Building.

COVID Specific FAQs

We are following the Department for Education’s guidance in relation to transport in response to COVID-19. Learners on dedicated educational services do not mix with the general public on those journeys and tend to be consistent. This means that the same advice for passengers does not apply on dedicated educational services from the autumn term, but students should still be encouraged to space out as much as possible on any enclosed transport. We are requiring that all students wear a face covering on all college services (both EYMS and minibus services) for the protection of all our students.

In line with the college’s overarching expectations, if any student is ill or presenting with any of the Covid-19 symptoms, they MUST NOT attend college or board any transport services.

What are the Covid-19 measures in place when using a Wyke College East Yorkshire Bus service?

Answer – All buses are cleaned thoroughly before every journey. You will need to wear a mask during your journey unless you have a valid reason not to wear one. No hand sanitisers are provided on the buses, so you should wash or sanitise your hands before travelling and on first entry to the college. You must avoid any contact between your hands and your face at all times.

What are the Covid-19 measures in place when using a Wyke College Minibus?

Answer – All minibuses are cleaned thoroughly before every journey. You will need to wear a mask during your journey unless you have a valid reason not to wear one. No hand sanitisers

are provided on the minibuses, so you should wash or sanitise your hands before travelling and on first entry to the college. You must avoid any contact between your hands and your face at all times.

Can I get a refund on my unused portion of my bus/minibus pass if a local lockdown occurs?

Answer – Should any local or national lockdown be put into place; we will ensure that no student is disadvantaged in relation to the amount they have paid. Depending on the situation, we may respond to this through refunds or deferring passes to subsequent terms. You will not be out of pocket should this happen.

What social distancing rules apply on the Wyke College East Yorkshire Bus service?

Answer – The services are dedicated to Wyke students only so will not need to comply with public service bus rules. This means that as much distance as possible should be maintained where possible. As fewer students will be using the services this should be easier to achieve. It is important to ensure you wear your face covering and sanitise your hands on arrival at the bus and as soon as you arrive at college. Do not consume any food or drink on the bus service.

What social distancing rules apply on the Wyke College Minibuses?

Answer – As much distance as possible should be maintained where possible when using a minibus. As fewer students will be using the services this should be easier to achieve. It is important to ensure you wear your face covering and sanitise your hands on arrival at the bus and as soon as you arrive at college. Do not consume any food or drink on the bus service.
