## **Applying to Wyke Sixth Form College and the Application Window**

Applications are welcome from any learner with a genuine desire to continue study at the College. Full details of the application procedure and support on how to complete the application can be found on our website ([www.wyke.ac.uk](http://www.wyke.ac.uk)) and on our [Applicant Advice Video](#).

Applications Open on **Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021** and our Priority application Deadline is **Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022**.

Applications will remain open beyond 20<sup>th</sup> February, however applications received after this date are not guaranteed an interview appointment. Applications submitted that are not fully complete may be returned to the applicant requesting further information.

### **Applicant Interviews**

All applicants who applied before the deadline will be interviewed concerning their interests, prior achievements, potential programme and aspirations. Interviews for all prospective students will be held during the colleges interview window and applicants should bring their most recent school report with them, which should try to include predicted grades, attendance, and progress.

Interview window - **December 2021 - April 2022**

An applicant may not receive an initial interview if the application is not fully complete.

### **Post Interview procedures and Enrolment**

After receiving a conditional offer applicants must confirm acceptance of the offer via the college's applicant portal. Here students can make changes to their profile, contact the college as well as receive regular updates regarding their Wyke applicant journey.

Applicants who have been interviewed and offered a conditional place at the College will be offered, where possible, an opportunity to participate in a taster event (Wyke Start) prior to enrolment which will assist them in making an informed choice about their programme of study.

Wyke Start Taster Event - **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> & Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

Applicants who have been interviewed and offered a conditional place at the College will be invited to attend an enrolment interview following the publication of GCSE results in August. Confirmation of results must be presented at the interview or no enrolment will be made.

Enrolment interviews will take place between **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> August – Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September**
