

Wyke Transport 2022/23

The College will again be maintaining the number of services being offered from September 2022. The cost of travelling to college will be no more than £1.50/journey on all College bus and minibus services when a pass is purchased. Details of fares, routes and pick-up points for buses and minibuses are available on the website at <http://www.wyke.ac.uk/student-life/travelling-to-wyke>

It should be noted that if your journey into college is within the 75p zone (*East Yorkshire Buses only*) you will be able to pay by cash on the bus itself. For those travelling further we recommend that you buy an East Yorkshire Buses '**e**' ticket no later than Tuesday 6th September 2022 ready for the start of term. An 'e' ticket can be purchased in six equal payments and must be acquired before the commencement of the next period.

To purchase a College '**e**' ticket you will need to download the free East Yorkshire Buses App onto your phone to buy an 'e' ticket (just search EY Buses in your phones App store). Tickets can be purchased from the beginning of enrolment week on Tuesday 30th August 2022. Exceptions can be made to this system if a suitable device is not available to operate the EY buses App. Please contact Alan Woodcock at the college on 01482 346 347 or email transport@wyke.ac.uk if this is the case.

To travel on a College minibus you can also buy an '**e**' ticket by downloading the free East Yorkshire Buses App onto your phone to buy an 'e' ticket (just search EY Buses in your phones App store). Tickets can be purchased from the beginning of enrolment week on Tuesday 30th August 2022. Exceptions can be made to this system if a suitable device is not available to operate the EYMS bus App. Please contact Alan Woodcock at the college on 01482 346 347 or email transport@wyke.ac.uk

Prices above are based upon £1.25 and £1.50 per journey plus a small annual admin fee.

Ad-hoc travel on buses and minibuses

Travel on East Yorkshire Buses outside of the 75p zone and all minibuses will be permitted on an ad-hoc basis without a pass but the cost will be double that of a normal journey.

On one of our minibus services you will need to buy single journey ticket from the college library, which again will be double pass price, before you travel. If you plan to also make a return journey on a minibus, make sure you buy two tickets!

Passes are transferable between East Yorkshire Buses and minibuses

College **'e' tickets** can be used on any of the East Yorkshire Buses services that are operated for the College and College minibuses. However, if you usually come into College on an East Yorkshire Bus service, you will need to check there is capacity on the chosen minibus you would like to use with the Head of Premises who is located in Oak 5.

Payment reminders

East Yorkshire Buses **'e-tickets'** will count down until the date you are due to make the next payment.

Financial help with travel costs

Support is available to help with the costs of travel passes via the 16-19 Bursary Fund. Completed applications for a Discretionary Award or Bursary must be submitted with the correct supporting evidence **no later than 31 July 2022** in order to be assessed before enrolment. Confirmation of the assessment will be made at enrolment and successful applicants will then be able to obtain their travel pass at the start of term without payment. Further information about the process for obtaining the travel pass will be provided at enrolment.

We can only guarantee to have travel passes available for the start of term if the application is received before the submission date and all the requested evidence received.

Applications made after the submission date will be assessed within 10 working days, and if further supporting evidence is required you will be notified in writing beforehand. Once the application has been assessed students will be notified of the outcome. Successful applicants will then be able to obtain their travel pass without payment. If the pass has already been purchased, the cost will be reimbursed.
